How web videos are better:

5 Ways Web Videos are Better Than Real Life

How web videos are better:

- Reach students outside of class, or flip your classroom
- Repeat, pause, reverse, control the teachers pace
- Digital Augmentation, - Pictures, Text, effects
- Consistent Lessons
- Direct communication to students

Types of Web Videos

- Vlog
- White Board / Screen Capture
- Educational / Demonstration
- Lecture

Vlog

- Filmed at a computer with a webcam
- Fastest way to make web videos
- Very Personal

Example:

Fixed Media

White Board / Screen Capture

- Focus is on content
- Use a program like CamStudio or ExplainEverything (iPad)
- Also very fast

Example (Dave Conservatoire) :

Introducing the Cycle of Fifths

Educational / Demonstration

- Explain concepts and demonstrate
- Takes longer, but gives more content

Example:

First Day of School Video

Lecture

- Record a regular class or guest speaker.
- Lapel Mic preferred
- Fits in with traditional methods of teaching

What do you need?

- Camera
- Microphone
- Computer
- Video editing software

Camera

- Web cams are a great place to start
- High definition cameras are a great upgrade, but audio is more important.
- I use Logitech and M-Audio, but there are a ton of great cameras out there.
- If you're not using a web cam, tripods are a must.
